The **2014 Public Policy Action Awards** will be presented at the State Convention Awards Ceremony at Honors Haven in April 25-27, 2014 and will be based upon the goals set forth in the 13 in ’13 Public Policy Challenge and our **AAUW-NYS Public Policy Priorities** (<http://www.aauw-nys.org/pp.htm>). Your Branch will earn a star(s) for each public policy activity undertaken from June, 2013 – April 1, 2014. Based on the number of stars earned, you’ll be awarded the Gold, Silver, Bronze or Honorable Mention Award at the State Convention.

Stars will be awarded on both the number and complexity of the actions taken.

Gold: 13 - 15 stars; Silver: 10 - 12 stars;

Bronze: 7 - 9 stars; Honorable Mention: 4 - 6 stars
