BRANCH SCRAPBOOKS

Scrapbooks are valuable tools for preserving branch activities and memories.

Each branch is encouraged to maintain a branch scrapbook.

Items that could be included:

Newspaper articles about the branch (photocopied on archival or acid free paper)

Newspaper articles about branch members, not necessarily related to their

AAUW participation (photocopied on archival or acid free paper)

Programs of meetings

Project summaries

Membership lists

Photographs – labeled - who, when, what, where

Memorabilia of meetings and projects

Pictures of event (place, candid shots, speakers), favors, programs

Anything your branch believes is relevant to highlight and preserve your branch activities, projects, and membership.

The scrapbook should be kept in the branch archives.
