MESSAGE TO MEMBERS ABOUT THE STATE OF THE STATE AND THE BINGO CARD:

Watch or listen to New York State Governor Cuomo as he delivers his 2014 State of the State Address live from the Empire State Plaza Convention Center in Albany, NY on **Wednesday, January 8, 2014 at 1:30 pm**. Every time the Governor mentions one of the key phrases on our BINGO Card, mark that space on the card. Remember – he may use several of these phrases more than once – that’s a good thing!

At the conclusion of the State of the State Address, tally up the Governor’s BINGO score. Here’s how:

Outer Ring (blue) is worth – 1 point per mention

Inner Ring (orange) is worth – 3 points per mention

Center (green) is worth – 2 points per mention

The Book (a mention in the fully printed State of the State, that is not mentioned during the public speech) – ½ point per mention

So if the Governor mentions ALL of the phrases on our BINGO card at least once, his minimum score will be **42 points**.

Scoring:

>40 points = D

40-50 points = C

50-75 = B

75-90 = A-

90-100 = A

NEXT STEPS:

AAUW-NYS will be Tweeting about the State of the State, and will release a public statement afterwards to let the Governor and the general public know what his “official score” is, and how we think his address stacks up against what New York women and families need. Please plan to share that public statement with your networks.

Share your BINGO results with family, friends, AAUW members, social media, your local news outlets, your legislators, and THE GOVERNOR. Let people know what you think of the Governor’s plan for New York State’s future. How does it compare to the future you want and expect for your state and your family?

Hang on to your scorecard! AAUW-NYS will refer to the Governor’s scorecard throughout 2014 to remind the Governor, our legislators, and the general public of the promises and shortcomings of the Governor’s administration throughout the year as we advocate for critical legislation to improve the lives of NY women.
