Every time a state candidate mentions one of the key phrases on the BINGO Card, put a tally in that space on the card. Remember – he or she may use several of these phrases more than once – that’s a good thing! Put a new tally in the space each time she/he mentions that key phrase, and let’s see how many of our policy priorities overlap with the candidate’s’ agenda. At the end of the debate, add up the candidate’s BINGO scores to see how each scored on issues for women and their families. Here’s how:

- Outer Ring (blue) is worth 1 point per mention**
- Inner Ring (red) is worth 3 points per mention**
- Center (green) is worth 2 points per mention**

Scoring: <40 points = D; 40-50 points = C; 50-75 = B; 75-90 = A-; 90-100 = A
